About Action Tutoring

Action Tutoring is an award-winning education charity that supports young people facing socio-economic disadvantage to achieve a meaningful level of academic attainment.

We partner with non-selective state schools across England to deliver **maths and English** tutoring programmes for pupils sitting their SATs and GCSEs. We work specifically with pupils who are **eligible for Pupil Premium funding and at risk of not reaching national standards** by the time they leave primary or secondary school.

How it works

- We provide 8 to 10 high-quality, DBS-checked and trained volunteer tutors to work with up to 20 **Year 7, 10 or 11 pupils**. Tutoring is delivered **online or face-to-face**.
- We run two consecutive **15-20 week** programmes across the academic year, which means we will support two different cohorts of up to 20 pupils.
- A **dedicated Programme Coordinator** inducts and engages pupils, attending the tutoring sessions each week. They also provide CPD and quality assurance for our tutors.
- We require a named **link teacher** in school who the Programme Coordinator will liaise with directly on a weekly basis.
- Programmes run from October until July. Your dedicated Programme Coordinator will reach out in September to schedule a programme set-up meeting.
- Schools receive weekly session updates, as well as pupil progress analysis and reporting.
